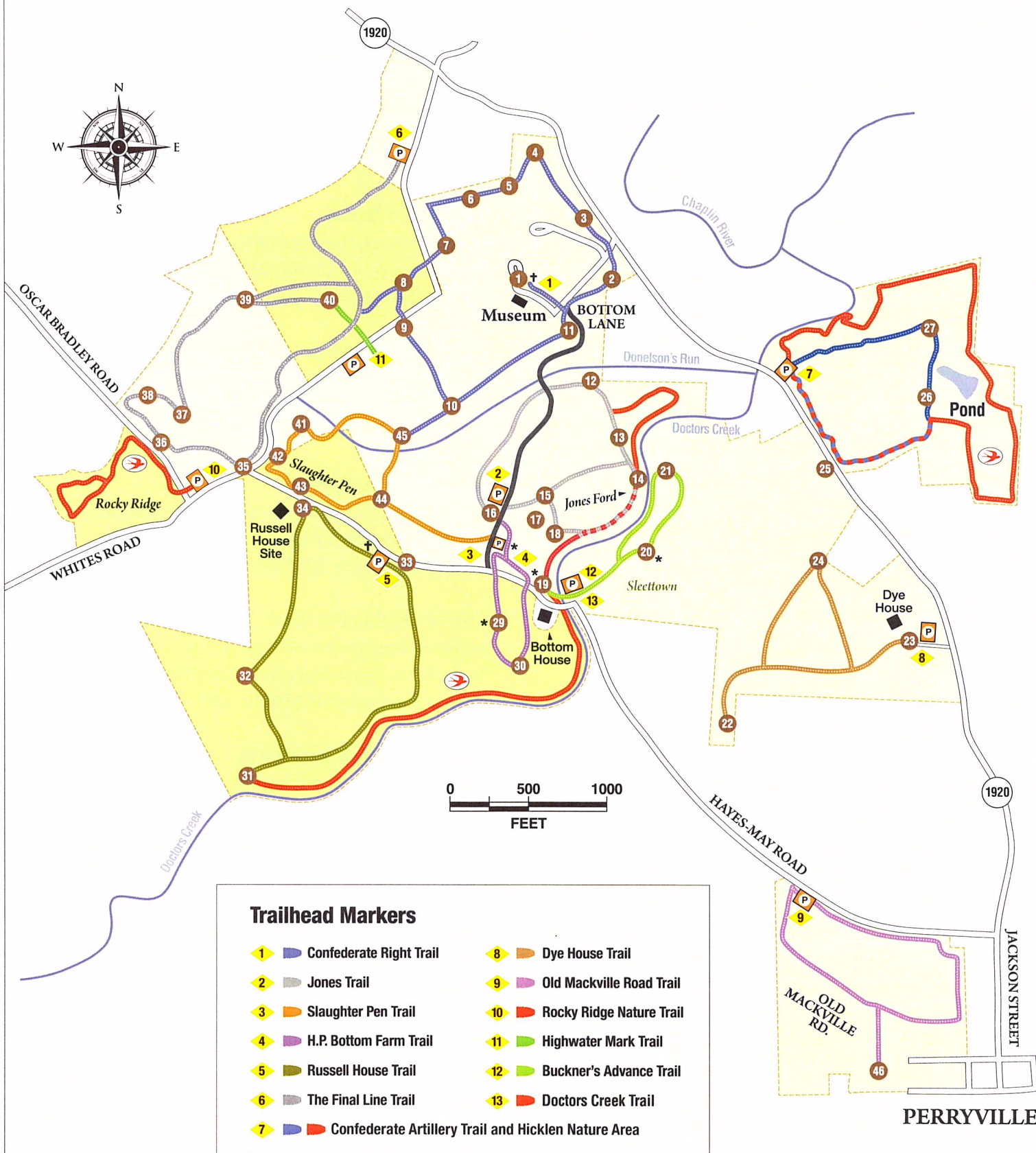
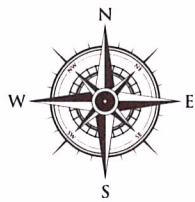

Trail 1: CS Right 1.75 miles

This is the main park trail. It covers the Confederate right flank. There are two cut throughs: to trail 6 at sign number 8; to trail 3 at sign number 10. Rolling hills.

Trailhead Coordinates: 37.67466N - 84.97043W

Trail 2: Jones' Ford 1.25 miles

Stone walls are visible on much of this trail. Forging the creek at Jones' Crossing will connect you to trail 12. To continue Jones' advance across the valley, follow markers between sign numbers 13 and 14. Very hilly.

Trailhead Coordinates: 37.66837N -84.97247W

Trail 3: Slaughter Pen 1.50 miles

Some of the highest casualties were sustained by units who engaged on this ground. There is a cut through at sign number 45 that will take you to trail number 1. Hilly.

Trailhead Coordinates: 37.66675 N – 84.97199W

Trail 4: H.P. Bottom Farm 0.50 miles

The Bottom Farm was caught between the Union and Confederate lines. The trail crosses the county road at two points. Please be alert to traffic. Rolling hills.

Trailhead Coordinates: 37.66632N – 84.97179W

Trail 5: Russell House 1.50 miles

The Russell Family House sat close to the Dixville Crossroads and burned in the 1960s. Used as headquarters by Union General Alexander McCook. It connects to trail 13 at sign number 31. Rolling hills.

Trailhead Coordinates: 37.66621N – 84.97529W

Trail 6: Final Line 2.25 miles

This trail takes you to the final line of engagement during the battle. A cut through close to sign number 40 leads to trail 1. Very hilly.

Trail 7: CS Artillery/Hicklen Nature Trail 2.25 miles

The Artillery Trail and Nature Trail split - follow mini ball markers for historic trail. Location of Carnes and Stanford Confederate batteries. Hilly.

Trailhead Coordinates: 37.67145N – 84.96061W

Trail 8: Dye House 1.30 miles

The Dye Family House was General Buckner's Headquarters during the battle. It was a hospital after the battle. Rolling hills.

Trailhead Coordinates: 37.66376N – 84.95683W

Trail 9: Old Mackville Road 1.25 miles

The Mackville Pike was the main roadway into the town of Perryville in 1862. Rolling hills.

Trailhead Coordinates: 37.65683N – 84.96115 W

Trail 10: Rocky Ridge 1.40 miles

Nature trail running along Wilsons' Creek. Scenic terrain and stonewalls are plentiful on this hike. Steep hills.

Trailhead Coordinates: 37.66859 N – 84.98324W

Trail 11: Highwater Mark 0.50 miles

Confederate troops made it no further north in the war's Western Theater than at the stonewall atop the "Mule Shoe." Rolling terrain.

Trailhead Coordinates: 37.67277N – 84.97701W

Trail 12: Buckner's Advance 1.25 miles

Confederate troops crashed into encamped Union forces along Doctor's Creek. This trail also has the remnants of an African – American community, Sleettown, which sprang up shortly after the war. Hilly.

Trailhead Coordinates: 37.66560N – 84.97032W

Trail 13: Doctors Creek 2.25 miles

Scenic trail stonewalls and abundant wild life are a feature of this walk. Hard charging Confederates scaled the wall below the Bottom House to engage the Union on the hills above the house. Rolling hills.

Trailhead Coordinates: 37.66560N – 84.97032W

Mileage is approximated

- Park closes at dark. Please plan your hike accordingly.
- No vehicles or bicycles on trails. No parking on grass.
- Trails are mowed grass and are the only designated hiking areas.
- Park only in designated trailhead parking areas. This is for your safety, as other public vehicles travel the county roads.
- Do not remove or disturb vegetation and wildlife.
- Do not remove any relic you might find. Report location to museum staff so appropriate fieldwork for artifact recovery can be performed.
